AN ORDER OF THE CITY MANAGER ACTING AS THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF ANTIOCH IMPLEMENTING A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE JUNE 1, 2020 ORDER AS AMENDED AND ENDING THE CITYWIDE CURFEW ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3, 2020 AT 4:30 PM

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, the City Manager, acting in the capacity of the City of Antioch's Director of Emergency Services, issued a Proclamation of a Local Emergency and an Order of the City Manager Acting as the Director of Emergency Services for the City of Antioch Imposing a Citywide Curfew;

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, the City Manager, acting in the capacity of the City of Antioch's Director of Emergency Services, issued a Proclamation and Order amending and extending the citywide curfew until 5:00 a.m. on June 8, 2020;

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2020, the City Manager, acting in the capacity of the City of Antioch's Director of Emergency Services, desires to end the City of Antioch citywide curfew effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, upon termination of the citywide curfew, the curfew order of the County of Contra Costa will apply to the City of Antioch until such order has ended.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that section 3 of the June 1, 2020 Proclamation and Order imposing a citywide curfew for the protection of life and property within the City of Antioch as amended by the June 2, 2020 Proclamation and Order of the Director of Emergency Services is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. Pursuant to this curfew, no persons shall be upon any public street, avenue, alley, park, way, or any other public place or upon unimproved private real property in the City of Antioch between the hours of **6:00 p.m.** and **5:00 a.m. each day** from **June 1, 2020** through the morning of **June 3, 2020** at **5:00 a.m.**

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that this amendment to section 3 of the June 1, 2020 Proclamation and Order as amended imposing a citywide curfew for the protection of life and property within the City of Antioch shall take effect immediately and end the citywide curfew at 4:30 P.M. on Wednesday, June 3, 2020.
